

Roadway Improvement Project

Upper Bay Road
Sanbornton Y Project
Sanbornton, NH



Upper Bay Road is a north/south highway corridor within the Town of Sanbornton, linking the I-93 / NH Route 3 area with the Steele Hill Resort area. The roadway also serves the rural residential area west of Winnisquam Lake providing connection to I-93.

A major portion of the roadway, approximately 8450 LF, is severely deteriorated exhibiting rutting and ponding of water within the travel lanes, no roadside drainage, and failing cross culverts. The roadway was approved for inclusion in the NHDOT Municipally Managed State Highway Aid Program for the Town of Sanbornton.

Due to the recurring freezing of ponded areas within the travel ways of a 1600 LF foot segment, QCC, as a subconsultant to The H.L. Turner Group Inc., acted under emergency measures to evaluate the roadway, develop an interim rehabilitation program and prepare construction documents for construction to occur in late fall of 2006. This program included new roadside drainage swales, cross culverts, and pavement shimming with overlay.

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
